

2nd Year Diploma, Flexible Learning [2-4 courses per term – Winter Start]

The **winter** start of the 2nd year Diploma is not a "fast track" option; a maximum of 4 courses are offered per term. This option does not allow for full-time student loans. The **winter** start does not follow the same sequences as the **fall** term start and takes a minimum of two years to complete.
